

PET PLACEMENT OPTIONS

There are many animals needing homes at any one time, so finding a home can take persistence. There are good homes out there, though, so try to stay positive during your search. We highly recommend making a flyer with your pet's description, pictures and contact information at vet offices, animal shelters, pet supply stores, etc. Using social media and neighborhood websites, such as Nextdoor, can also increase your audience when trying to find a good home for your animal. If you adopt to someone that you don't know, ask for an adoption fee or bring the animal to their house to help ensure that the home is suitable.

LifeLine Animal Project: Two locations offering low cost spay/neuter and vaccines. They are experienced in handling feral cats.

PAWS Atlanta: Operates a full service vet clinic while also providing low cost spays/neuters for cats and dogs

Planned Pethood of Georgia: Provides low cost spay/neuters and vaccines. They are experienced in handling feral cats and help facilitate TNR.

National Spay Alliance Foundation: Provides low cost spay/neuters.

S.A.F.E.: Provides low cost spay/neuters.

SpayGeorgia: Spay Georgia provides spay/neuter certificates that can be redeemed at participating clinics for discounted services.

Well Pet Humane: Affordable veterinary medicine.

West Georgia Spay/Neuter Clinic: Low cost spay/neuter for dogs and cats.
