

PET PLACEMENT OPTIONS

We strongly recommend writing a story and placing pictures of your pet with contact information at area vet offices and animal shelters (many have bulletin boards for just such a purpose). There may also be a place in area pet supply stores, supermarkets, general stores, etc. for these stories and pictures. Letting your friends and neighbors know that you have a pet to place for adoption is another good idea. Using social media as well as neighborhood websites, such as Nextdoor, can also increase your audience when trying to find a good home for your animal. If you are adopting to someone that you don't know, asking for an adoption fee or bringing the animal to their house are ways to help ensure that the home is suitable.

The following list provides information regarding the names and contact information for local rescue groups and shelters, which may be able to assist you with placing your pet. Please check with the specific organizations for details on how they handle adoptions and whether they will be able to accept your pet at this time.

- Are you a no-kill shelter?
- Are you able to accept the animal at this time? If not, approximately when? (You may be placed on a waiting list.)
- Do you screen potential adopters? Do you make follow-up calls after adoptions? (Many organizations check the status of the pet to be sure that the animal and the new adopter are compatible.)

CatSnip: Project CatSnip offers mobile services including, spay/neuter, dentals and vaccines for cats and dogs at multiple locations in the metro Atlanta area. They are experienced in handling feral cats as well.

Cherokee Humane Society: Spay-Neuter Assistance Program (SNAP) provides low cost spay/neuter vouchers for dogs and cats for the county's residents who qualify.

Humane Society of Cobb County: Provides low cost spay/neuter certificates for use at participating veterinary clinics.

LifeLine Animal Project: Two locations offering low cost spay/neuter and vaccines. They are experienced in handling feral cats as well.

PAWS Atlanta: Operates a full service vet clinic while also providing low cost spays/neuters for cats and dogs.

National Spay Alliance Foundation: Provides low cost spay/neuters.

SpayGeorgia: Spay Georgia provides spay/ neuter certificates that can be redeemed at participating veterinary clinics for discounted spay/neuter services.

Well Pet Humane: Affordable veterinary medicine.

West Georgia Spay/Neuter Clinic: Low cost spay/neuter for dogs and cats.
